Correctional Psychiatry Services — Facility Partnership Overview

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Ageless Minds partners with jails, detention centers, and correctional facilities across Indiana to deliver timely, evidence-based psychiatric care for adolescent, adult, and older-adult populations. Services are designed to improve access to mental health treatment while supporting facility operations, security constraints, and documentation requirements.

SERVICE OPTIONS

Telepsychiatry

Secure, HIPAA-compliant virtual clinics that expand access while reducing transport and security burden.

On-site clinics

In-person psychiatric coverage may be available for facilities seeking an onsite provider.

Medical director support

Psychiatric consultation and collaboration with correctional healthcare leadership.

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What to Expect After Your Inquiry

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— ENGAGEMENT TIMELINE

1. Response within one business day

We acknowledge your inquiry and confirm the primary point of contact at your facility.

2. Discovery call (30-45 minutes)

We review population size, current mental health coverage, referral volume, security workflow, EHR, and pain points.

3. Written service proposal

You receive a proposal outlining service model, clinic cadence, coverage hours, scope of practice, and fee structure.

4. Contracting and credentialing

Agreement execution, facility credentialing, background clearance, and required onboarding documentation.

5. Technical and workflow setup

Telepsychiatry platform testing, EHR access, referral and scheduling process, escalation and crisis pathways.

6. First clinic and ongoing review

Care begins on the agreed schedule, with periodic review of access, throughput, and documentation quality.

— TELEPSYCHIATRY COMPLIANCE

- All virtual visits are conducted over an encrypted, HIPAA-compliant platform; consumer video tools are never used.
- Care is delivered by an Indiana-licensed psychiatric provider; patients are located in a facility within the state at the time of service.
- Informed consent for telehealth is obtained and documented before treatment begins.
- Prescribing follows Indiana and federal requirements, including DEA rules for controlled substances and any in-person evaluation requirements.
- Documentation is completed in the facility's record system and meets correctional and payer standards.
- A business associate agreement is executed with each facility, and privacy, room-setup, and staff-presence expectations are agreed in advance.

— FREQUENTLY ASKED BY FACILITIES

How quickly can services begin?

Most partnerships move from first call to first clinic within four to six weeks, depending on credentialing and technical setup.

Can you cover both adults and adolescents?

Yes. Care is provided for adolescent, adult, and older-adult populations, including geriatric residents.

Who handles documentation?

Notes are completed in the facility's record system, following correctional and payer documentation standards.

Are controlled substances prescribed?

Only when clinically appropriate, within DEA and Indiana requirements and the facility's formulary and security policies.
